WIPO ADR for PCT, Madrid and Hague Users

The **WIPO Arbitration and Mediation Center's** alternative dispute resolution (ADR) clauses and services are used by multinational corporations, SMEs, R&D centers, universities, inventors and designers from around the world, many of whom are also users of other WIPO services. The WIPO Center offers a 25% reduction on its administration fees if a party (or both parties) to a submitted dispute is (are) named as applicant or inventor in a published Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) application, or a holder of an international registration under the Madrid System for trademarks or the Hague System for designs.

Patent-related disputes account for some 30% of WIPO arbitration and mediation cases, and trademark-related disputes for some 20%.

Domain Name Jurisprudential Overview 3.0

The new 3.0 edition of the **WIPO Jurisprudential Overview** promotes efficient resolution of cybersquatting disputes by helping WIPO parties prepare their case. This essential filing tool covers over 100 topics, references some 1,000 representative Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (UDRP) decisions from 265 WIPO panelists and captures numerous developments in the Domain Name System and WIPO UDRP jurisprudence. Since the previous edition of the Overview in 2011, the number of UDRP cases administered by the WIPO Center has more than doubled, including a record year in 2016.

New Domain Name Dispute Resolution Service for .EU and .SE

The WIPO Center has started offering dispute resolution services in relation to domain names registered under .EU (European Union) and .SE (Sweden). This brings the number of country code Top Level Domains (ccTLDs) for which the WIPO Center provides services to 76.

Practitioners' Views on Life Sciences Dispute Resolution

In light of increasing numbers of life sciences mediations and arbitrations filed with the WIPO Center, the WIPO Center has published a **Compilation of Practitioners' Views on Life Sciences Dispute**

Resolution. This Compilation assesses the current use of ADR processes and court litigation in life sciences disputes, and sheds light on party dispute resolution strategies and best practices in this area.

WIPO External Offices

WIPO currently maintains External Offices in Rio de Janeiro (Brazil), Beijing (China), Tokyo (Japan), Moscow (Russia) and Singapore. WIPO's **network of External Offices** forms an integral part of the Organization and brings WIPO's services and cooperation closer to Member States, stakeholders and partners.

Among other activities supported by WIPO External Offices, the WIPO Office in China recently helped organize ADR workshops in Beijing (June 21), in cooperation with the State Intellectual Property Office of the People's Republic of China (SIPO), and in Shanghai (June 22), in cooperation with the Shanghai Intellectual Property Administration (SIPA).

IFIA and the WIPO Center Collaborate on ADR for Inventors

The International Federation of Inventors' Associations (IFIA) and the WIPO Center have entered into collaboration to raise awareness of mediation and arbitration options for intellectual property and technology disputes among IFIA's members.
